While these constraints posed challenges, they inspired us to implement more performant frontend solutions.

We utilised Next.js with server-side rendering (SSR) on Cloudflare infrastructure, leveraging CDNs strategically positioned close to our customer base. To reduce the computational burden on users' devices, we implemented a backend-for-frontend (BFF) architecture that employed Cloudflare Workers to handle resource-intensive tasks. Additionally, we adopted techniques such as lazy loading, minification, caching, and monitoring tools like Lighthouse to optimise performance further.
